

Task Force III

Task Force III has been organized at the request of the Concord School Board to assist the school district in the process of determining the best uses for the school buildings that could be available for uses other than regular school programs as of September 2012. Task Force III is the third of three task forces that have been part of the School Board's master plan for consolidation of the elementary schools in Concord.

Task Force III is a group of citizens from the Concord community who possess deep knowledge of Concord and have expressed an interest and willingness to participate.

The Task Force will serve in an advisory role to the school district and to any consultant that the school district hires to help with the process of determining the best uses of the school facilities in the future.

Members of the Task Force will assist in planning and implementing additional public input sessions such as neighborhood meetings, meetings with city officials, or groups who may be interested in any one of the facilities (e.g. Senior Center representatives).

Final decisions and actions regarding the use of the facilities will be taken by the School Board, the elected, deliberative body.
